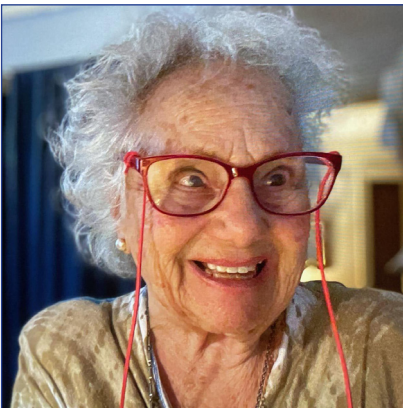
The Iris Network saved my life! ~ Thalia
